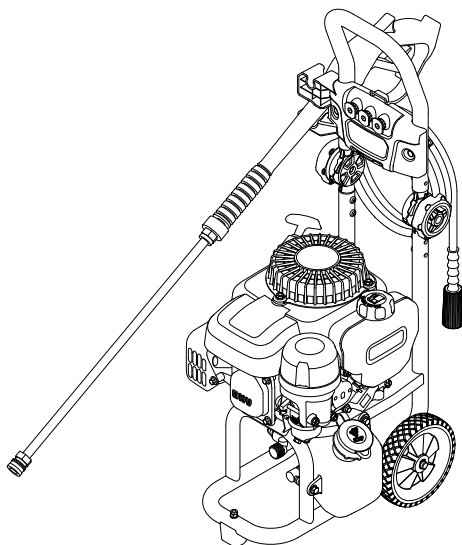

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I. Operator safety

1. Safety rules



Pay attention to this safety alert symbol. Obey all safety messages that follow this symbol to avoid possible property damage, INJURY or DEATH.

Each safety message is preceded by a safety alert symbol and one of three words, DANGER, WARNING, or CAUTION.

DANGER

Indicates a hazardous situation which, if not strictly complied with, will result in substantial property damage, serious injury or DEATH.

Unauthorized modified any part of the generator or for any unsuitable usage is allowed.

WARNING

Before each use, check for loose or damaged parts, signs of oil or fuel leaks, and any other condition that may affect proper operation. Repair or replace all damaged or defective parts immediately.

Locate all operating controls and safety labels.

Keep all safety guards in place and in proper working order at all times.

DO NOT allow any material to block the cooling slots.

DO NOT allow children or untrained persons to operate the engine.

DO NOT run the washer unattended. Turn off the washer before leaving.



WARNING

KICKBACK

Rapid retraction of the starter cord will pull hand and arm towards the engine faster than you can let go.

Unintentional startup can result in entanglement, traumatic amputation or laceration. Broken bones, fractures, bruises or sprains could result.

WARNING

Read the instructions provided with the equipment that powered by this engine for any additional safety rules that should be observed in conjunction with washer startup, shutdown, operation, or protective apparel that may be needed to operate the equipment.

◆ Use caution when positioning the pressure washer for use. Warm air from engine could cause discolored spots on grass.

◆ Never direct a water stream toward people or pets, or any electrical device.

◆ Before starting any cleaning operation, close doors and windows. Clear the area to be cleaned of debris, toys, outdoor furniture, or other objects that could create a hazard.

◆ Never pick up or carry a machine while the engine is running.

◆ Never starting the machine if ice has formed in any part of the equipment.

◆ Do not use acids, alkalines, solvents, flammable materials, bleaches, or industrial grade

solutions in this product. These products can cause physical injuries to operator and irreversible damage to the machine.

◆ Always operate the machine on a level surface, if the engine is on an incline, it could seize due to improper lubrication (even at the maximum lubricant level).

◆ **WARNING:** High pressure jets can be dangerous if subject to misuse. The jet must not be directed to persons, animals, electrical devices, or the machine itself.

◆ Hold the trigger handle securely with both hands. Except the trigger handle to move when the trigger is pulled due to reaction forces. Failure to do so could cause loss of control and injury to yourself and others.

◆ Never attempt to make any adjustments while the engine (motor) is running (except where specially recommended by the manufacturer).

◆ Protective covers must always cover rotating parts when the engine is running.

◆ Keep cooling air intake (starter grip and rope area) and muffler side of the engine at least 3 feet away from buildings, obstructions, and other

combustible objects.

◆ Keep the engine away from flammables and other hazardous materials.

◆ Keep away from hot parts. The muffler, exhaust gases, and other engine parts become very hot. Do not touch muffler or place any body parts in the path of hot exhaust gases, which can cause burns and other serious personal injuries.

◆ Do not touch the spark plug and ignition cable when starting and operating the engine.

◆ Check fuel hoses and joints for looseness and fuel leakage before each use.

◆ Always refuel outdoors. Never refuel indoors or in a poorly ventilated area.

◆ Never store the machine with fuel in fuel tank inside a building where ignition sources are present, such as hot water and space heaters, clothes dryers, and the like.

◆ If the fuel tank has to be drained, do this outdoors into a container approved for gasoline and away from all ignition sources.

◆ To reduce the risk of fire and injury, handle fuel with care. It is highly flammable.

◆ Do not smoke while handling fuel.

◆ Add fuel before starting the engine. Never remove the cap of the fuel tank or add fuel while the engine is running or when the engine is hot.

◆ Loose fuel cap slowly to release pressure and to keep fuel from escaping around the cap.

◆ Replace all fuel tank and container caps securely.

◆ Wipe spilled fuel from the unit. Move 30 feet away from refueling site before starting engine.

◆ If fuel is spilled, do not attempt to start the engine but move the machine away from the area of spillage and avoid creating any source of ignition until fuel vapors have dissipated.

◆ Never attempt to burn off spilled fuel under any circumstances.

◆ Before storing, allow the pressure washer to cool for 30 minutes and drain the fuel from the unit.

◆ Store fuel in a cool, well-ventilated area, safely away from spark and/or flame-producing equipment.

◆ Store fuel in containers specifically designed for this purpose.

◆ Empty fuel tank and restrain the unit from moving before transporting in a vehicle.

◆ When servicing use only recommended or equivalent replacement parts. Use of any other parts may create a hazard or cause product damage.

◆ ONLY use cold water.

◆ Make sure minimum clearance of 3 feet is maintained from combustible materials.

◆ Never spray close to the surface to be cleaned as you can damage the surface.

◆ After stopping the engine, always pull the trigger on the trigger handle to relieve the stored pressure in the high pressure hose. Failure to do so could result in serious personal injury.

◆ Ensure the high-pressure hose is properly connected before using the product.

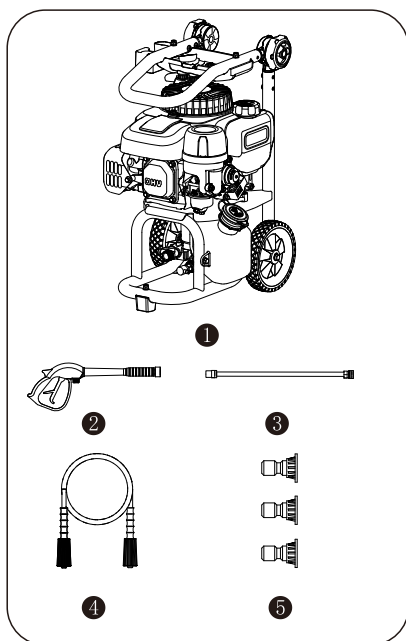

II. Before Operating

1. Unpacking

Remove the high pressure washer from the Shipping Carton

- a. Place the shipping carton on a solid, flat surface.
- b. Carefully cut each corner of the carton box from top to bottom. Fold each side flat on the ground.
- c. Remove everything from the carton except the high pressure washer.

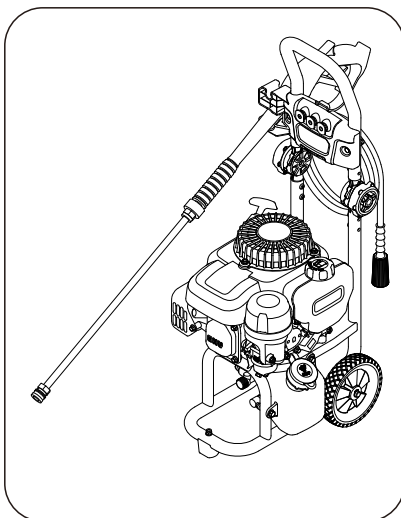
2. Assembly

Your high pressure washer requires some assembly. If you have any questions regarding the assembly of your washer, please have your model number and serial number ready and consult your local dealer for help.

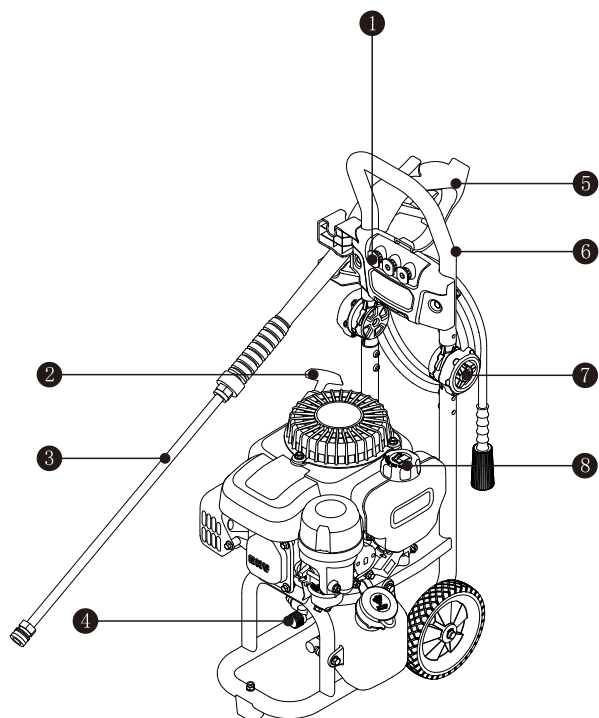

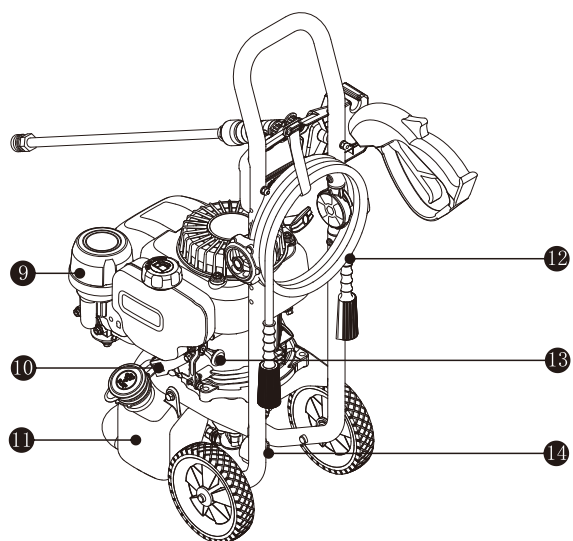

III. Operating

1. Operating checklist

1 Operating Location

Only use OUTSIDE and place the washer in a well-ventilated area and only operating washer in a suitable usage, consult your local authorized dealer if you have any question about engine usage.

Place the washer on a stable and flat surface, and keep surroundings clean and dry.

Additional rules may be comply if washer is used in some specific area and condition, consult your local authorized dealer for more information.



⚠ DANGER

TOXIC FUMES

The exhaust of the engine contains carbon monoxide, an odorless, colorless, poison gas. Using engine indoors **CAN KILL YOU!**

NEVER use inside any building or any kind of enclosure, **EVEN IF** doors and windows are open.

Place the engine in a well-ventilated area and carefully consider wind and air currents when positioning the engine.

2 Operating Condition

Check for loose or damaged parts, signs of oil or fuel leaks, and any other condition that may affect proper operation. Repair or replace all damaged or defective parts immediately.

⚠ WARNING

Failing to correct problem(s) before operation could result in property damage, serious injury or DEATH.

Remove any excessive dirt or debris, especially around the muffler and recoil starter.

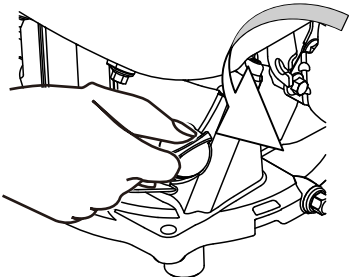
Do not move or turn over the washer when engine operating.

3 Engine oil

Place the engine on a level surface with engine stopped.

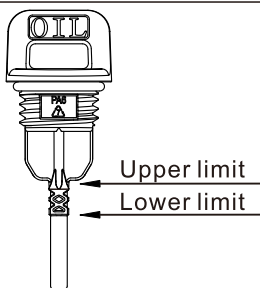
Remove the dipstick and wipe it clean.

Reinstall dipstick into tube; rest on oil fill neck, **DO NOT** thread cap into tube.



Remove dipstick

Remove the dipstick again and check oil level. Level should be at top of indicator on dipstick.



Oil level gauge

Fill to the upper limit of the dipstick with the recommended oil if the oil level is low. SAE 10W-30 is recommended.

Reinstall and fully tighten the dipstick.

Refer to **add oil** instruction in **MAINTENANCE** section for more information.

Oil capacity (rated):0.4L.

⚠ WARNING

This engine is not filled with oil at the factory. Any attempt to crank or start the engine before it has been properly filled with the recommended type and amount of oil may result in engine damage and void your warranty.

⚠ CAUTION

Operate the washer in a flat surface only.

Engine with low oil sensor will be automatic shut down when oil is lower than the lowest limited level.

Please add oil to the upper limit level in case of any accident, check the oil level frequently.

⚠ WARNING

Oil is a major factor affecting performance and service life. Use 4-stroke automotive detergent oil recommended in the **MAINTENANCE** section of this manual.

4 Engine fuel

With the engine stopped, check the fuel level gauge. Refill the fuel tank if necessary.

⚠ CAUTION

Pressure can build up in the fuel tank. Allow the engine to cool for at least two minutes before removing fuel cap. Loosen the fuel cap slowly to relieve any pressure in the tank.

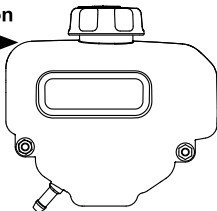
Regular unleaded gasoline with a minimum octane rating of 90.

DO NOT mix oil with gasoline.

Be sure not to fill above the upper limit mark. Always allow room for fuel expansion.

Fuel capacity (rated):0.75L.

⚠ DANGER

Do not fill the fuel tank above the upper limit. Over fill will result in engine die or damage the carbon canister (if equipped) and void your warranty.



⚠ DANGER

FIRE OR EXPLOSION

Gasoline is highly flammable and extremely explosive.

Do not fill fuel when washer is operating or in a high temperature.

Keep flammable items away while handling gasoline.

Fill fuel tank outdoors and in a well-ventilated area with the washer stopped.

Always wipe off spilled fuel and wait until the fuel has dried before starting the washer.

DO NOT operate the washer with known leaks in the fuel system.

Use proper fuel storage and handling procedures. **DO NOT** store fuel or other flammable materials nearby.

Keep fire extinguisher handy and be prepared if a fire starts.

NEVER use engine or carburetor cleaner products in the fuel tank or permanent damage may occur.

It is important to prevent gum deposits from forming in essential fuel system parts, such as the carburetor, fuel filter, fuel hose or tank during storage. Also, experience indicates that alcohol-blended fuels (called gasohol, ethanol or methanol) can attract moisture, which leads to separation and formation of acids during storage.

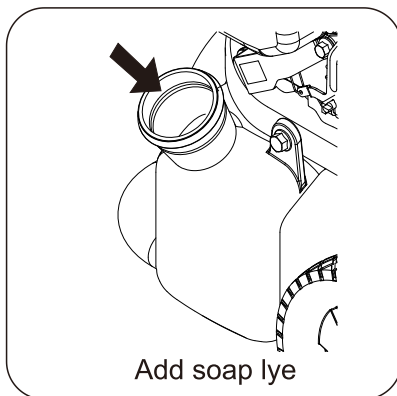
Acidic fuel can damage the fuel system of the washer while in storage. Be sure to review the instructions given in "Storage" on page 24.

Gasoline/Alcohol Blends: up to 10% alcohol, 90% unleaded gasoline by volume is approved as a fuel. Other gasoline/alcohol blends are not approved. Effects of old, stale or contaminated fuel are not warrantable.

⚠ CAUTION

To minimize gum deposits in your fuel system and to insure easy starting, add fuel if needed. do not use gasoline left over from the previous season.

Open the pot cap to add soap lye.

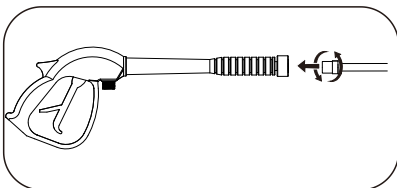

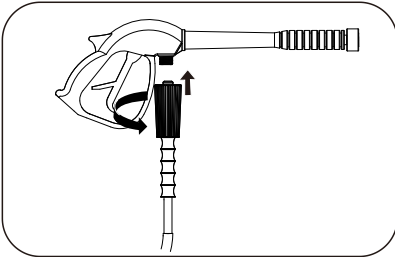
Do not use any detergent with function of bleaching or solution.

6 Accessory assembling

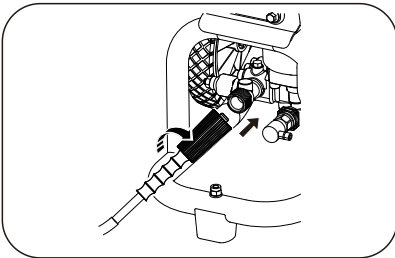
a. Connect the gun barrel with pistol grip.



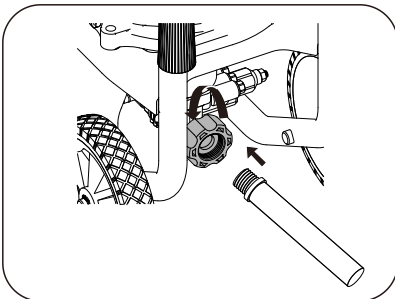
b. Connect the pistol grip with high pressure pipe.



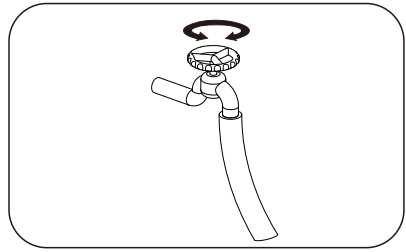
c. Connect high pressure pipe with pump outlet.



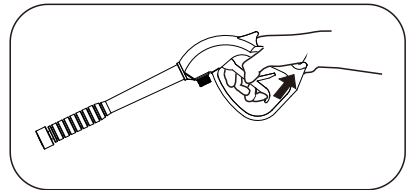
d. Connect water outlet pipe with pump water inlet.



e. Open water inlet pipe faucet.

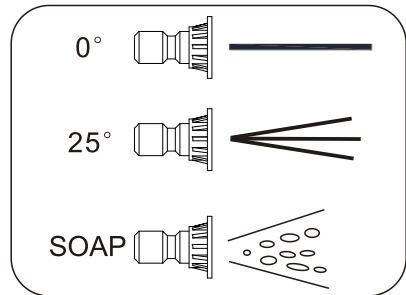


f. Check out the trigger.

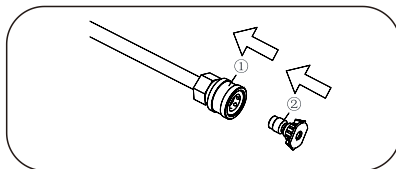

⚠ CAUTION

Siphon only work in low pressure jet operation, choose black low pressure jet if washer(not high pressure) should be used.

Choose a suitable jet for certain washing, damage on washing surface will happen if choose a wrong one.

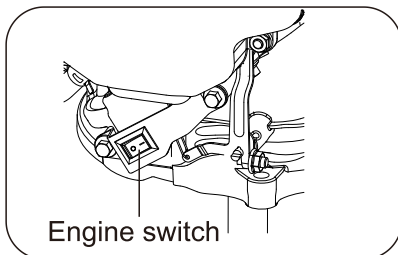

⚠ CAUTION

Operate the washer when inlet pipe leak or without water will result in washer damage.

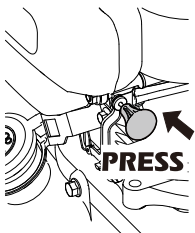

Turn the stop lever to “ ” position, which means turn washer “ON”.

Turn the choke lever to “**CHOKE**” position.



⚠ CAUTION

Choke may be in different width for temperature or many other factors. Keep choke in “**RUN**” position when hot re-starting the engine.

⚠ WARNING

Check starter cord conditions before operating. Have it replaced immediately by local authorized dealer if cord is frayed.

When starting engine, grasp the recoil starter handle and pull slowly until resistance is felt. Then pull rapidly to avoid kickback.



⚠ WARNING

KICKBACK

Rapid retraction of the starter cord will pull hand and arm towards the engine faster than you can let go.

Unintentional startup can result in entanglement, traumatic amputation or laceration. Broken bones, fractures, bruises or sprains could result.

⚠ CAUTION

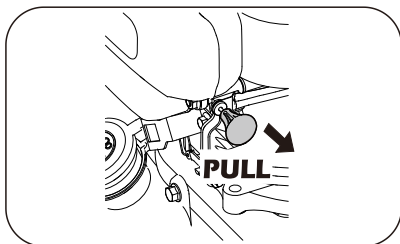
If engine still can not start after 3 attempt starts or stalls after starting, check and make sure high pressure washer is stay in flat surface within enough oil.

⚠ CAUTION

Check oil level when engine is in break-in process, see maintenance chapter for recommended maintenance schedule.

Move choke lever slowly to “**RUN**” position and check if engine running stable and any other noise.



6

Choose a suitable jet, and handle jet tightly, start the washer aiming at washer item.

⚠ CAUTION

Wear eye protection to protect you eyes when operate the washer.

Strong kickback will produce when high pressure water jet out. do not operate the washer on wet slide surface in case of any accident happen, make sure handle jet tightly when operating the washer.

Different jet has different function water jet, choose a suitable one for better washing effect and protect washing surface.

⚠ WARNING

Avoid gun keep “**OFF**” position for long time, it may result in pump damage or personal injury.

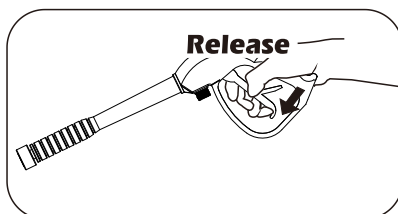
⚠ DANGER

High pressure jet water performance like a cutter, which could penetrate skin or clothes easily, so do not running washer aim at yourself /others or pet.

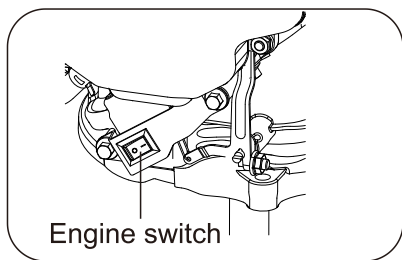

Release the pistol grip to stop the jet and let engine run 10s.



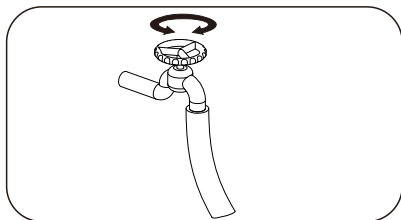

Keep engine stop lever on “**O**” position.



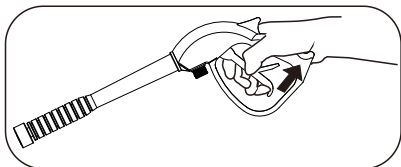

Turn on the jet to release the pipe inner pressure.

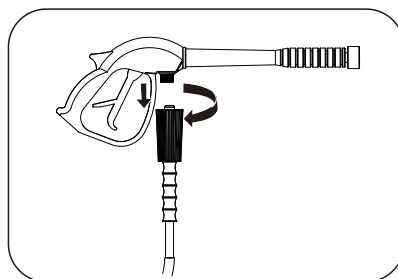
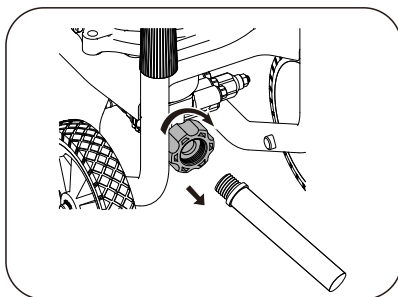


⚠ DANGER

High pressure water may remain in pressure pipe, which could penetrate skin and cause injury. please pay attention to release jet pressure after engine stopping or when water supplying.

The way to stop engine on emergence: remove the spark plug or turn the stop lever to “O” position.

⚠ DANGER

Do not stop engine with load unless any emergence happens.

IV. Maintenance

It is the owner's/operator's responsibility to complete all scheduled maintenance in a timely manner. Correct any issue before operating the washer. Always follow the inspection and maintenance recommendations and schedules in this manual.

Before servicing the washer, **release pressure in the jet** and allow the engine to cool down.



DANGER

Accidental starts can cause severe injury or death. Remove and ground spark plug wire before performing any service.

WARNING

Improper maintenance or failure to correct a problem before operation can cause a malfunction and result in property damage, serious injury or DEATH.

Improper maintenance will void your warranty.

CAUTION

The filter element may contain PAHs, PAHs are harmful for your health. Please wear gloves for protection during air filter maintenance.

1. Maintenance schedule

Service the washer in a clean, dry and flat area. Follow the service intervals indicated in the chart below. Service your washer more frequently when operating in adverse conditions.

Contact your local service dealer for your washer maintenance needs.

NOTE:

- 1.Applicable types.
- 2.Before each season and after then (whichever comes first).
- 3.Service more frequently under severe, dusty, dirty conditions.
- 4.To be performed by knowledgeable, experienced owners or the authorized dealer.

2. General maintenance

Use a wet cloth to clean surface of the washer.

Use soft brusher to remove the dirty and oil on surface.

Use compressed air(25PSI) to clean all remained dirty on the washer.

Check all ventilation and cooling paths to keep them unblock and clean.

⚠ WARNING

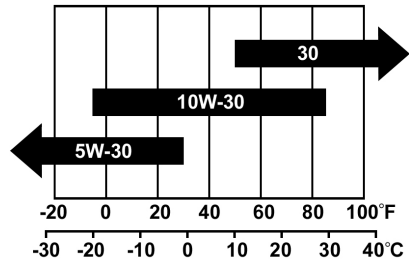
Using water to clean the washer is forbidden since water may go in washer through cooling path and result in parts rust.

Tampering with any set of washer is forbidden.

Do not modify the engine speed in any way. do not tamper with governed speed. supplier correct rated frequency and voltage when running at factory set. Tempering with the factory set will void your warranty.

Engine oil

SAE 10W-30 is recommended for general, all-temperature use. Other viscosities shown in the chart may be used when the average temperature in your area is within the indicated range.

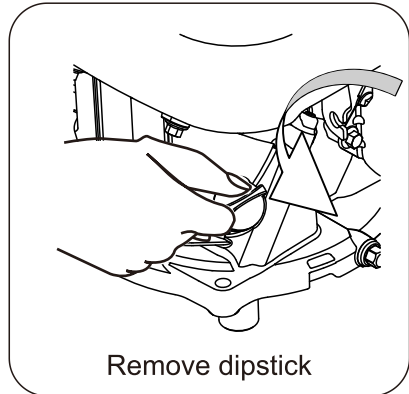

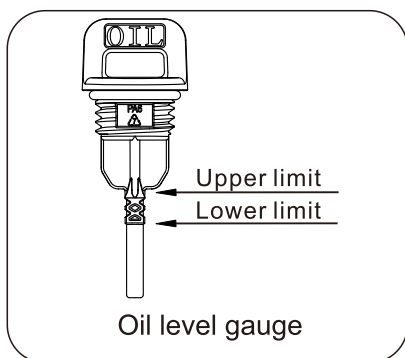
Oil capacity (rated):0.4L.

Add oil

- 1.Place the washer on a level surface.
- 2.Remove the dipstick and wipe it clean.



- 3.Add recommended oil to the upper limit.



⚠ CAUTION

Oil level check

Reinstall dipstick into tube; rest on oil fill neck, DO NOT thread cap into tube.

4. Fully tighten the dipstick.

Change oil

⚠ CAUTION

Change oil when the engine is warm from operation.

1. Place the washer on a level surface.

2. Remove oil dipstick.

3. Remove the oil drain plug and allow the oil to drain completely.

4. Replace and fully tighten the drain plug.

5. Add recommended oil to the upper limit (see add oil instruction above).

6. Reinstall and fully tighten the dipstick.

7. Dispose of used oil at an approved waste management facility.

⚠ WARNING

The engine is not filled with oil at the factory. Any operation before it has been properly filled with the recommended type and amount of oil may result in engine damage and void your warranty.

Air filter

1. Screw out the lock nut and remove the air filter cover.



2. Take down the filter element.

3. Clear away internal impurities.

4. Place the filter in the assembly.

5. Reinstall the air filter cover and snap in place.

⚠ WARNING

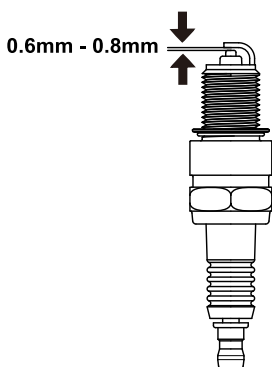
DO NOT run the engine without the air filter, serious danger can result.

Spark plug

1. Clean any dirt from the spark plug cap and spark plug base.
2. Remove the spark plug cap.
3. Using socket wrench to loose and remove the spark plug.
4. Inspect the spark plug and spark plug washer, if it's damaged or worn, replace with new one. Clean the spark plug with wire brush if reuse it.
5. Check spark plug gap. Carefully bend side electrode to adjust the gap if necessary.

Spark plug gap:

0.6mm - 0.8mm



Check spark plug gap

6. Carefully thread the plug into the engine **by hand**.

7. After the spark plug is seated, use spark plug wrench to tighten the plug.

Spark Plug tighten Torque: 20-25 N.m

8. Attach the spark plug wire to the plug.

⚠ WARNING

Only use recommended spark plug or equivalent. DO NOT use spark plugs that have improper heat range.

Valve lash adjustment

Each gasoline engine is debugged and inspected strictly by the company in the factory. generally, the machine can work properly without any adjustments. After use for sometime you may need adjust the gap as follows:

**Note: gap standard
intake gap (0.10-0.15),
exhausted gap (0.15-0.20)**

1. Hold the valve gap adjusting nut, and release the valve locking nut.
2. Rotate the valve gap adjusting nut to a predetermined gap.

3. Hold the valve gap adjusting nut and tighten the valve locking nut according to the predetermined torque.

4. Tighten the valve locking nut and then check the valve gap again until it is in the line with the standard.

Pressure jet

Water jetting deformed or being not uniform shows some block in the jet. use fine pin to insert the nozzle to remove the blocking.

Pressure gun

Check gun barrel when engine is in low speed or stop, and connect water, then continue to on/off jet to see if pistol is flexible and then check leakage.

Water inlet and filter

Check if there is any fracture on water inlet pipe and if there as any block on pump filter.

High pressure water pipe

Check if high pressure water pipe is leakage by visual.

DANGER

High pressure water may be rush out from pipe when high pressure washer operating if pipe is leakage, this water rush could penetrate skin and cause injury. please check pipe before every usage.

VI. Storage

DO NOT mix oil with gasoline. The engine should be started at least once every 2 weeks and allowed to run for at least 20 minutes. Follow the instructions below for longer term storage if the engine will be out of service for 2 months or more.



⚠ DANGER

Fire or explosion

Gasoline is highly flammable and extremely explosive. Empty the fuel tank and take back the brake before storing or transporting this engine.

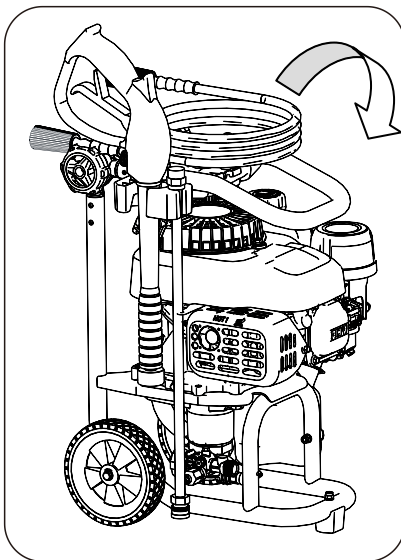
1. Allow washer completely cool before storage.
2. Service the washer according to the instructions in the Maintenance section.
3. Drain all fuel completely from the fuel tank, fuel hose and carburetor.
4. Replace oil.
5. Drain of water in outlet pipe and pump.
6. Remove spark plug and pour about 1 oz. of engine oil into cylinder. Reinstall spark plug. Crank engine slowly to distribute oil and lubricate cylinder.

7. Mount the spark plug.

8. Use dust-proof or carton to protect machine when storage.

9. Store the unit in a clean, dry area out of direct sunlight.

10. You can loose handle nut to fold it for room saving. when storage, do as follows:

1.For pump of farm-oriented, engine and main parts are warranty for 12 months, easy damage parts are warranty for 3 months, and plastic parts are not in warranty.

Main parts: crankcase and cover, crankcase shaft, flywheel, the washer body and the rack. Easy damage parts: spark plug, oil sealing, gasket, rubber seal, O-ring seal

2.All damage caused by quality issue can service freely maintaining during warranty.

3.Certain charges will happen when repairing or maintaining with no invoice or expired warranty.

4.According to country's warranty law, if any exchange or return caused by quality issue happened in 7-day's purchase, it must keep all follows done, such as packed well, completed enclosed parts and completed styling without any artificially damages. Or the customer will respond for the warranty.

5.Please show your purchase invoice and the warranty cards when warranty happens, and fill the warranty card at the Special Maintenance Station. Please reserve the card well in case of warranty and it will never re-get when it lost.

6.All conditions below are not in warranty but can be repaired by certain charge or lifetime service:
